So o o o you want to learn how to shoot a US service rifle? And you want to shoot **RAPID FIRE** (the only time this allowed on any range is during a clinic or matches)

THEN THIS CLINIC IS FOR YOU

This clinic is open to any US citizen 14 years or older with a maximum number of 40 students. And will provide instructions for the new junior and adult shooter who wish to shoot the U. S. Service rifle in competition, and will also provide the instructions for match operations. It will provide those new shooters with the opportunity to earn their temporary "NRA high power rifle classification card" that is used in sanctioned NRA matches.

The instructors conducting the clinic are certified NRA rifle instructors and are also high power rifle competitive shooters

The entry fees for this clinic and its match:

\$60.00 fD.S.C. members

\$90.00 non D.S.C. members

\$30.00 juniors 14 – 18 years.

Entry fees include all class material, match fees, ammunition fees and the use of a rifle (if needed).

Due to limitations of the range a non-refundable pre-registration reservation fee of \$40 for adults and \$15 for juniors is requested. In order to insure the ample supply of class materials, fees or deposits must be received **before 27 May 2008**, all entries received after this date will be placed on stand-by.

Students who wish a confirmation are to include a self addressed post card or a valid e-mail address with their entry.

- MATCH DATE:** SUNDAY JUNE 08, 2008
- LOCATION:** THE DETROIT SPORTSMAN'S CONGRESS RIFLE RANGE

- ENTRY FEE:** MATCH ENTRY FEES AND NRA REGISTRATION ARE INCLUDED IN THE CLINIC FEE.
- ENTRIES:** THIS MATCH IS OPEN **ONLY** TO THOSE PERSONS WHO ATTENDED THE CLINIC. THERE ARE **NO POST** (RANGE WALK-ON) ENTRIES ALLOWED FOR THIS MATCH
- STARTING TIME:** ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE CHECKED IN BY 0930 FOR SQUADDING AND SAFETY MEETING PRIOR TO THE FIRST ROUND. FIRST RELAY WILL BE CALLED TO THE LINE AT 0950 WITH THE FIRST SHOT AT 1000.
- RIFLES ALLOWED:** U. S. SERVICE RIFLE .30 cal M1 GARAND WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE LINE. AR-15's WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR USE BY THE JUNIORS AND LADIES **ONLY**. STUDENTS WISHING TO USE THEIR OWN M1 GARAND RIFLES **MUST** HAVE THEM PASS A SAFETY INSPECTION AND APPROVAL FOR USE BY THE DSC TECHNICAL ADVISOR PRIOR TO THEIR USE IN THIS MATCH.
AMMUNITION WILL BE PROVIDED FOR GARANDS AND JUNIORS SHOOTING THE AR'S
- CLASSIFICATION:** CLASSIFIED STUDENTS **MUST** SHOW PROOF OF CLASSIFICATION, A RECENT MATCH RESULT BULLETIN, TEMPORARY SCOREBOOK OR NRA CLASSIFICATION CARD.
- MATCH RULES:** THE MATCH WILL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CURRENT "NRA HIGH POWER RIFLE" RULES.
NRA RULE 9.12 WILL BE IN EFFECT (NO REFIRES ALLOWED)
- MATCH SCHEDULE:** ALL FIRING WILL BE CONDUCTED AT 200 YARDS.
COMPETITORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SCORE TARGETS.
ALL SCORING WILL BE DONE ON THE FRAME.
SIGHTING SHOTS WILL BE ALLOWED PRIOR TO MATCH 1 OF EACH RELAY.
(5 SHOTS IN 10 MINUTES ANY POSITION)
- COURSE OF FIRE: (50 ROUNDS PLUS SIGHTERS)**
- PHASE 1:** SLOW FIRE STANDING POSITION — 10 SHOTS IN 10 MINUTES (SR - 200 YD TARGET)
- PHASE 2:** RAPID FIRE STANDING TO SITTING POSITION — 10 SHOTS IN 60 SECONDS (SR - 200 YD TARGET)
- PHASE 3:** RAPID FIRE STANDING TO PRONE POSITION — 10 SHOTS IN 70 SECONDS (SR-42 — 300 YD REDUCED TARGET)
- PHASE 4:** SLOW FIRE PRONE POSITION — 20 SHOTS IN 20 MINUTES (MR-52 — 600 YD REDUCED TARGET)
- NOTE:** **THERE WILL BE 3 MINUTE PREPARATION PERIODS PROVIDED FOR THE RAPID FIRE PHASES OF THE MATCH. FOR SLOW FIRE - BLOCK TIMES WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHIEF RANGE OFFICER.**
- AWARDS:** NRA CERTIFICATES WILL BE AWARDED TO ALL STUDENTS FOR SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING THE TRAINING.
- MISCELLANEOUS:** NO LUNCH BREAK WILL BE TAKEN AND ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE ADVISED TO BRING THEIR OWN LUNCH, SNACKS AND DRINKS.
(WATER AND POP ARE AVAILABLE AT THE RANGE).
